I am requesting funding for the Southwest Innovation and Medical Gateway project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Grove City, at 5690 North Meadows Drive, Grove City, Ohio 43123. The funding would be used for an overpass that would provide economic benefits and job creation for Grove City. The overpass would also cause considerable community benefit through improved connectivity and new land uses to service residents, employers, and visitors. The overpass will result in development patterns that create more jobs and higher paying jobs than could be achieved without the overpass, resulting in more income tax generation to continue to provide exceptional services to residents, employers, and visitors.
